

- UK productivity 16% below G7 competitors
- Poor management costs UK economy £84bn per year
- Brexit creating uncertainty 57% of managers report this as a concern





### **MANAGEMENT AND UK PRODUCTIVITY**

"Studies suggest that the average UK manager is less proficient than many overseas competitors, while management skills could account for a quarter of the productivity gap between the UK and the US."





### A NATION OF "ACCIDENTAL" MANAGERS

- Only 1 in 5 trained
- 71% of organisations don't train well or at all!
- > 2m managers needed by 2024 (UKCES)




## MANAGEMENT DRIVES GROWTH & PRODUCTIVITY


- > 74% expect to grow the number of manager and leaders
- Highest % for 5 years
- > Above 60% every year since 2010

- > 54% female

- 54% of parents say degree apprenticeships better VFM than "traditional" routes
